

Background

Boyd's Crossing consists of 40 single-family, detached homes with a mix of two- and three-bedroom layouts. The development features smart, high-performance homes grouped around a shared green space on 9 acres just outside the Norfolk town center.

Developers wanted to maximize energy efficiency through sustainable design, green building practices, solar photovoltaic (PV) systems, renewable energy, and smart home technology.
