## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### INCENTIVE REQUIREMENTS

Contractor company becomes eligible to receive training and tool reimbursements when a qualifying AC Check or MS Check technician has completed at least three passing AC Check or MS Check tests within the same calendar year that the training was completed. AC Check contractors also become eligible for listing on the program website and ability to offer the HEAT Loan financing to customers for central A/C and heat pump measures, when completing at least three passing AC Check tests within the same calendar year that the training was completed.

Contractor company may receive up to \$200 for AC Check training and \$100 for MS Check training reimbursement, and up to \$150 for eligible tool purchases, per qualified technician. Eligible AC Check training is the full training curriculum, which includes review of the "Introduction to Airflow" online video and half-day classroom training. Eligible MS Check training includes the two-hour classroom training.

AC Check contractor company may NOT offer customers the 0% HEAT Loan financing on central A/C and heat pump equipment until it is listed on the Mass Save Heating & Cooling AC Check Trained Contractor list, found at MassSave.com.

In order to receive benefits and reimbursements, the qualifying technician must have completed the passing three AC Check or MS Check tests within the same calendar year that the training was completed and the tools were purchased.

If three passing AC Check or MS Check tests by a qualified technician are not achieved within the same calendar year as the training and tool purchases, then the contractor company is not eligible for those reimbursements or benefits.

In order for the contractor company to continue to be listed as an AC Check trained contractor on MassSave.com, and to continue offering the 0% HEAT Loan to customers for central A/C and heat pump equipment, at least one qualifying technician from the company must submit three passing AC Check tests annually (each calendar year). Failure to comply with minimum production requirements will result in removal from the list of AC Check trained contractors, and the company may not offer the 0% HEAT Loan for central A/C and heat pump equipment. Additional training and testing may be required for reinstatement.

If your company is not listed on the MassSave.com website as an AC Check trained contractor, your company is not authorized to offer the 0% HEAT Loan financing for central A/C and heat pump equipment.

### GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

**Application Form:** This application must be filled out completely, truthfully and accurately. The authorized company representative must date and submit the completed application along with all required documentation for specific incentives. By submitting the incentive application, the contractor agrees to abide by these Terms and Conditions.

**Time Limit:** Eligible training, tool purchases and qualified passing AC Check and MS Check tests must be completed between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018. Applications must be postmarked by January 31, 2019. Program is subject to change without prior notice, including rebates and incentive levels.

**Payments:** From the time the application is processed and approved, please allow 6–8 weeks for payment. Payment processing will take longer if information or documentation is missing from the application.

**Geographic Requirements:** Offers valid only for contractors servicing residential electric customers in MA where the Mass Save Heating & Cooling Program is offered by Cape Light Compact, Eversource, National Grid, and Unitil.

**Contractor Certification:** Contractor certifies that installation and services performed have been in accordance with all applicable municipal, state and federal codes, standards and regulations, as well as program requirements.

**Approval and Verification:** The participating utility or energy efficiency service provider reserves the right to conduct field inspections to verify installations and services.

**Tax Liability:** Sponsors will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the contractor as a result of the payment of incentives.

**Endorsement:** Sponsors do not endorse any particular manufacturer, product, system design, or technology in promoting these offers.
