

The Sponsors of Mass Save® offer Tier II rebates for eligible boilers and furnaces if the existing heating system is inefficient and non-condensing. In order to qualify for Tier II rebates, a verification of the existing heating system is required. Customers must complete and submit this form along with any supporting documentation of the previous system type (e.g., manuals or photos) with the rebate application. Approval is subject to review of the provided documentation. Systems must be installed by August 31, 2024, and applications submitted or postmarked by September 30, 2024, to be eligible for rebates.

In addition to existing residential heating system eligibility criteria:

- Customers replacing existing condensing furnaces or boilers are not eligible for Tier II rebates (refer to the rebate form for details). If pursuing Tier II rebates, verification of pre-existing heating system is required. Customers can be verified either through a Home Energy Assessment or by submitting photos of the pre-existing system and the new system once installed.
- Existing equipment pre-verification is not required for combined condensing furnaces and boilers with on-demand tankless water heating models and oil furnaces.
